
What will OPJS look like?

- All children will be expected to attend. DfE Guidance is being followed with regards to any exemptions to this.
- Children will not be in 'bubbles' but opportunities for children to mix will be limited.
- **Uniform** is compulsory (including shoes!) although children will need to wear OPJS PE kit to school on their allotted PE days so that there's no need to change.
- We will be minimising the use of shared spaces and resources.
- Pupils will have their own resource pack provided by school. **No pencil cases are required so please SAVE YOUR MONEY! ②**
- Children will need to bring in a bag/book bag for their reading book, snack etc.
- There will be continued cleaning throughout the day.
- Each year group will have a designated toilet.
- OPJS Breakfast Club and After School Club will continue! Email is on its way!
- Children will need to bring in their **own water bottle.** There will be opportunity for children to refill their bottles at set points throughout the day.
- Children will be **outside** as often as possible.

Drop off (by 8.45am)

A few points:

- **As always** we would like **all children to walk** to school as much as possible so as to avoid any parking issues.
- With regards to parking, we would appreciate that if you intend to travel to school by car then please avoid the back lane and park away from the school and Ascension Church.
- There will be a School Crossing Patrol.
- **Drop Off** Children will enter through the main gate and no parents/carers will be allowed onto the playground. Please queue outside of the main gate and observe social distancing. It's a case of simply walking up the path and dropping child at gate then walking onwards. Diagram below.



Pick Up

- The main gate will open at 3.15pm to allow parents/carers onto the playgrounds.
- Y3/4 Parents/Carers to wait on North (Stadium) playground and exit via main gate and wooden gate. Please be aware of the road between OPJS and Ascension!
- Y5/6 Parents/Carers to wait on South playground and leave via side entrance



Please note: Given the number of children and parents at the end of the day, we would appreciate a swift exit off the playground to ensure a smooth flow through the school and avoid any bottlenecks.
